

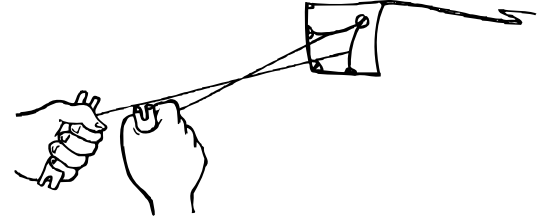
Instructions for Diamond Wing Stunt Kites From Gomberg Kite Productions

Note: Your kite bag contains a molded plastic nose fitting for the kite, and a small package of train lines. Please don't misplace them!

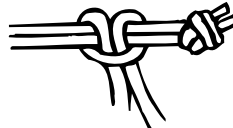
Assembly: Carefully insert the molded nose fitting into the end of the center spine and then connect the two leading edge spars. This may be a tight connection. Make certain the spars are fully inserted into the fitting. Then connect the support struts into the center spine and to the fittings on the leading edge spars.

Launching: Stand the kite on one edge with the nose pointing toward the ground. You can use your lines to maintain tension if you stake them down.

Using the handles or straps, pull back slightly on the line attached to the skyward side of the kite. This will tilt the wing forward and allow the wind to lift it into the air. To provide some extra lift in lighter winds, step back as you pull the kites into the air.



Stacking: Your kite includes a small package of train lines and connection loops. To fly a second kite behind the first one, remove the bridle line from the second kite. Notice that the four bridle lines are held to the kite at three connection points..



Attach line loops at the three bridle points on the first kite. There will now be a pigtail facing forward (attached to the bridle) and a second pigtail facing back. Attach the train lines to the three pigtails
