


# Solaris Cellular Kite



Assembly of your new Solaris could not be more simple.

This cellular kite comes with ten short fiberglass spars. Insert the flat end of each rod into the spoke at the center of the kite. The notched end of the spar then slips over the fabric tab at each outside corner. After inserting a few sticks, the kite will quickly take shape!

**Here is the important part. Bridle lines are connected to three of the spars. Attach the piece with the shortest line first and save the remaining two for later.**

**When you are finished, the short bridle will create the bottom edge of the kite, and the other two will be at the top. Be sure to space the top two spars with another spar between them.**



Once assembled, you can connect your flying line to the Solaris bridle, and gently loft it into the breeze.
